CUSTOMS AND EXCERPTS FROM THE BY-LAWS

Regular members may bring guests to the social meetings, but no person living in the community and not a member of the corporation shall attend more than two meetings a year.

There shall be no guests at the Birthday Meeting.

Members may telephone reservations for the luncheon to the reservation chairman or hospitality chairman up to noon Monday preceding the luncheon.

All members will be expected to serve alphabetically on the luncheon committee.

Any member delinquent for six months will be dropped from the roll and may be re-instated upon rayment of half of the initiation fee, the delinquent dues and the current year's dues in advance.

Any member desiring to withdraw from the corporation shall send a written resignation to the secretary. Membership may be renewed upon the payment of one-half the initiation fee and the dues in advance for the current year.

Any member seeking membership in the corporation after the lapse of six months of the regular session shall pay the regular initiation fee and one-half (½) year's dues.
